

# We're migrating to a new catalog get ready to meet –

# Evergreen!

This month, all of the public libraries in Westchester County will be moving to a new catalog system called Evergreen. We're excited for this switch because it will give our patrons a fantastic catalog experience, including:

- Better and easier search capabilities
- A more user-friendly design
- Greater control over your notifications

But migrating to a new catalog won't happen overnight. Our current system needs to be moved over to the new system and that means our catalog will be offline for three days: March 11, 12, and 13.

## What does this mean for you?

- For the three days our system is offline, the library won't be able to check in items
- We won't be able to place holds
- Holds won't be coming in
- We won't be making new library cards
- We won't be able to do item searches

- You won't be able to access the databases and digital collections you access with your library card number
- You may need a guest pass in order to access our public computers

## What about overdue materials?

During the time the system is offline, no fines will accrue and the checkout period will be extended so nothing will come due over these three days!
